HUNGER RELIEF

Cross-Lines operates a Community Kitchen, Community Market, and the USDA Commodities program. The Community Market provides fresh healthy food for 15 meals and essential toiletries once every two months. The Community Kitchen, which relies heavily on volunteer labor, serves hot breakfast, lunch, and sack lunches five days a week.

HOUSING STABILIZATION

The Housing Stabilization Program promotes housing and family stability by providing rent and utility assistance, as well as homeless re-housing services and homeless prevention services. Our Resource Navigators work with people to address immediate needs and also help them find long-term financial stability.

VOLUNTEERS

Cross-Lines has just 19 staff members, so we depend on over 1,900 volunteers each year to help us provide programs and services to meet the needs of our community.
