KCK Cold Weather Shelter Update



Opening

The Shelter is currently operating whenever temperatures drop below 25°F.

Location

The shelter is hosted at the Willa Gill Center, located at 645 Nebraska Ave., Kansas City, KS 66101. Each night, the shelter will be set up and torn down to ensure the Willa Gill Center's

daily services and programming are not disrupted.

Details

The shelter is open on nights when the forecast predicts temperatures of 25°F or below. A decision will be made by 8:00 AM each day about whether the shelter will operate that evening. Guests may begin lining up at 5:30 PM, and doors will open at 6:30 PM.

The shelter accommodates up to 40 adults (no children allowed) and cannot accept overflow guests. Visitors will receive a warm meal, a sleeping mat, a blanket, and a tent for the night. In the morning, guests will be provided a grab-and-go breakfast before leaving at 7:00 AM.

Call 913-725-0079 for daily updates. The hotline will be updated by 8:00 AM each morning to indicate whether the shelter will be open that night.


